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INSTITUTIONS PARTICIPATING IN PHARMGRAD: 2020-2021

The 2020-2021 PharmGrad Applicant Data Report was developed by the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy and reflects data for 10 schools and 22 graduate pharmaceutical education (MS/PhD) programs that participated in PharmGrad during its 6th admissions cycle. "Schools" in this report refers to the colleges and schools of pharmacy that participated in PharmGrad. "Programs" refer to graduate pharmaceutical degree and certificate programs that utilized PharmGrad. Participation changes during the 2021-2022 cycle are not reflected below, nor included in this report. OVERALL APPLICANT AND APPLICATION TRENDS

The 2020-2021 PharmGrad Applicant Data Report reflects 422 applicants with verified application status who applied via the Pharmacy Graduate Application Service (PharmGrad) during the 2020-2021 (6th) admissions cycle. Applicants with Submitted status sent a total of 463 applications to 10 colleges and schools of pharmacy and 22 programs that participated in PharmGrad.

The PharmGrad Applicant Data Report differs from the annual PharmCAS Applicant Data Report in several ways. Firstly, the PharmGrad report refers to applicants with Submitted status, while the PharmCAS report refers to applicants with Verified status. The PharmGrad Applicant Data Report also provides fewer tables because the application fields and processing differ in the following ways:

- No acceptance data is captured from PharmGrad programs.
- No disadvantaged fields are captured on the PharmGrad application.
- Full transcript verification is not available in PharmGrad.
- The PCAT is not required by PharmGrad programs.

Data in this report may differ from WebAdMIT and other AACP reports due to differences in how the data were collected, organized, and verified.

Figure 2: Number of Schools and Programs Participating in PharmGrad (2016-2021)




Figure 3: PharmGrad Applications per Applicant Ratio (2016-2021)




Figure 5: Total Number of PharmGrad Applicants (2016-2021)





Figure 9: Percentage of PharmGrad Applicants by Sex

Figure 13: PharmGrad Applicants by Race/Ethnicity




Figure 14: Percentage of PharmGrad Applicants by Race/Ethnicity and Sex



Figure 19: Percentage of PharmGrad Applicants by Citizenship Status




Figure 20: Country of Citizenship for PharmGrad Applicants
