


HEALTH PROFESSIONS WEEK 2023-2024 VIRTUAL FIELD TRIP

Health Professions Week (HPW) is seeking schools, colleges and programs interested in being a part of our 2023-2024 Virtual HPW Field Trip. HPW will host up to 50 Virtual Tour/Virtual Open House promotional videos during the 2023-24 Season this year.

GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS/PROGRAMS/COLLEGES:


There are 50 Virtual Field Trip (VFT) spaces available for 2023-2024. Individual universities/colleges/programs will be recognized as "programs" for the purpose of these guidelines.

- Field trip locations will be limited to recognized programs of participating HPW professions: (Anesthesiologist Assistant, Athletic Training, Audiology & Speech-Language Pathology, Chiropractic, Dental Professions, Health Administration, Medicine, Naturopathic Medicine, Nurse Anesthetists, Nursing, Optometry, Orthotics and Prosthetics, Osteopathic Medicine, Pharmacy, Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics, Physical Therapy, Physician Assistant, Podiatric Medicine, Occupational Therapy, Public Health, Respiratory Care, Social Work, and Veterinary Medicine.)
- A "Virtual Field Trip" should consist of a video tour, open house or other "prospective student content" hosted by the program in a video format. This video will be made available via a link from the Daily Event Content for HPW2022 with a brief description of the program tour.
- VFT videos must be available on an external player (e.g., YouTube, Vimeo, edu site, etc.). HPW will not be accepting or hosting video files (e.g., .MP4, .MOV, .AVI).
- Participating programs agree to share engagement data for the duration of HPW with HPW staff for the purpose of aggregate engagement reporting.
- We are seeking a wide geographic disbursement of programs across North America.
- A roster of available VFT's will be made available during the 2023-2024 Season on the HPW PURL pages, will be included in social media campaigns in the fall of 2023 for both high school and college students.


The cost for participating programs will be \$200 and will remain on the HPW PURL website for 12 months. Then, the 2023-24 VFT will be archived and remain in the HPW library for another 2 years.

We have 40 spots left for the VFT this year, and I hope to fill all of our seats with excellent programs! This is the 2nd year of the pilot program HPW is hosting in response to the data we collect on what types of events or information past student attendees have suggested or requested HPW provide. As this is a pilot program, HPW will be collecting extensive behavior data and survey data from our 2023-2024 participants. We will ask that our participating schools/colleges/programs (collectively "Programs") also provide as much information as possible at the conclusion of the season, May 31, 2024 (Click-Through Rates (CTR), Opt-In Data, Views, Downloads, etc.). In return, HPW will market the VFT on it's PURL page for students, educators, and family members and from time to time feature the VFT in social media. Our final report will include these data points as well as any opt-in data from participants during the season.

Registration forms are due back to HPW by June 1 and notifications/billing will be sent by July 1. All content links are due to HPW by July 15 and the VFT will be live on the HPW PURL on August 1. The cost to participate is \$200. The VFT Program will be available on the HPW PURL for 12 months and then available in HPW Archive for 2 additional years.

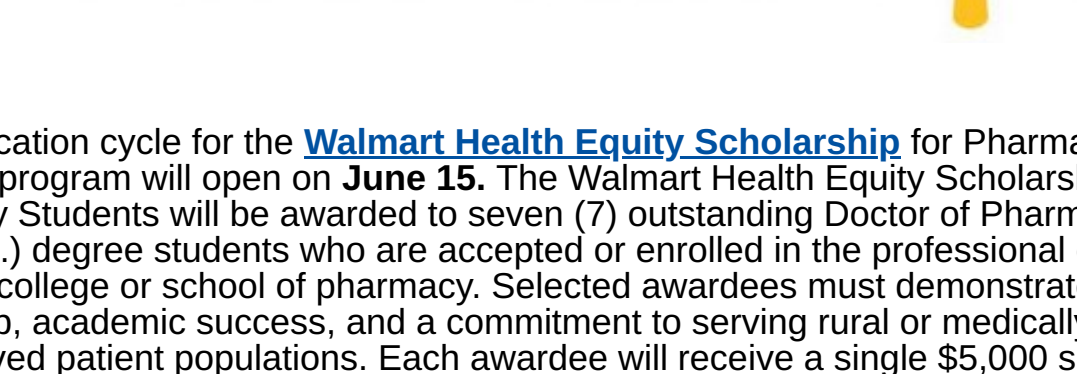
