# **BACKGROUND**


When drafting an email to an applicant in WebAdMIT, users can select from various carbon copy (CC), blind carbon copy (BCC), and reply-to options:


When an applicant responds to a school email sent via WebAdMIT, the reply is not sent back to WebAdMIT. Instead, it is sent to the email address designated under **Reply-To**. By default, the Reply-To email address is the one you use to log into WebAdMIT. However, some users have asked for a way to have the replies sent to a different email address, such as a general pharmacy school email or another colleague.

### **SOLUTION**

WebAdMIT allows you to manage the email addresses for the CC, BCC, and reply-to options. Additionally, users can send a preview of an email to these addresses using the Email Addresses feature. To customize your email copy and reply-to options, go to the Management menu and select Email Addresses.



Follow the prompts in this section to enter as many additional email addresses as needed. Once configured, the new email addresses are available for selection when composing an email.
